EIIS serves infants and children ages 0-8 who are experiencing similar difficulties as those served by SART, but with less severe symptoms.

Treatment is provided by clinicians and rehabilitation specialists. Services are funded through Medi-Cal and Mental Health Services Act.

WHO SART HELPS

SART supports infants and children ages 0–5 who may be experiencing social, emotional, behavioral, developmental, or learning concerns.

A complete evaluation is necessary to make a difference in your child's life. Early support leads to better outcomes.

Parents and caregivers are given the support and guidance needed to promote the child's continuum of care at home and in school.

YOUR CHILD MAY BENEFIT FROM SUPPORT IF YOU NOTICE:



BEHAVIOR

- Aggressive behavior
- Excessive tantrums
- Difficulty calming
- Behavioral concerns



DEVELOPMENT

- Speech concerns
- Attention concerns
- Sleep difficulties
- Developmental delays



EARLY HISTORY

- Prenatal exposure to drugs and/or alcohol
- Difficulty with regulation or comfort

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



1 SCREENING

Your child will be screened using the Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) and the ASQ Social Emotional.



2 ASSESSMENT

A transdisciplinary team will complete an assessment of your child's needs.



3 REFERRAL

You will receive treatment recommendations and appropriate referrals.



4 TREATMENT PLAN

Services are provided to help your child grow, learn, and thrive.

SERVICES MAY INCLUDE:

- PCIT (Parent Child Interactive Therapy)
- Play Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Dyad Therapy Linkage
- Medication Support
